

The Totalitarian Canada

I have owned and operated my website since 1 January 2001. I have fifteen years of actuarial science consulting experience in Toronto, San Francisco, Calgary, and across North America. I spent three years consulting to the CFO and treasurer of Canadian Pacific Limited developing portfolio theory models before the company broke up into its five subsidiaries in 2001. I

am The smartest person who ever lived—by a fucking longshot—because I can see the elephant in the room. And I can prove it with total and complete mathematical certainty.
